Church Visit

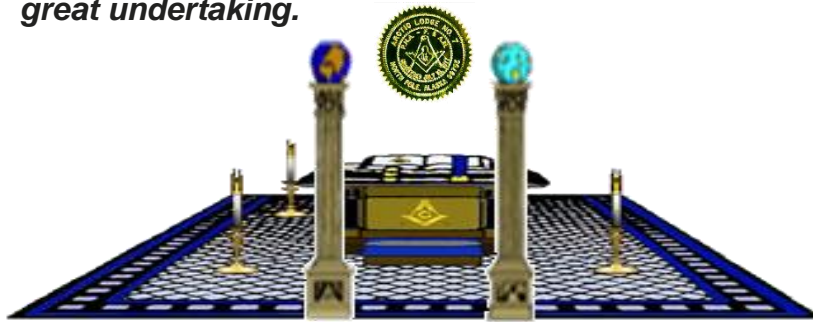

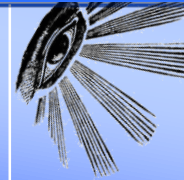

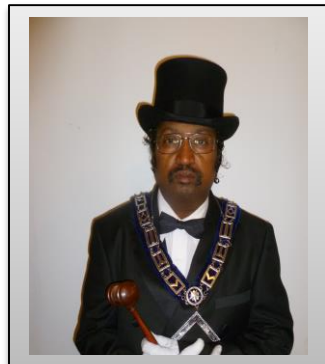
